Dear Parent/Guardian,

Thanks to all of our families who have returned your 2016-2017 Intent Forms. If you have not yet sent yours in please do so immediately. Financial Aid Forms for Preschool through Grade 8 for the (BEF) Bishops Education Fund and (SOS) Scholastic Opportunity Scholarship are available on our website. I strongly encourage all eligible families to apply for financial aid. The forms must be postmarked by **March 15, 2016**. You must get your pastor to sign your form before submitting it. Parishioners of St. Bernadette Church can get a form signed by Father Tony at the school office.

Along with your March tuition bill, if your fundraising fee is not already paid, you will receive a fundraising statement reflecting the first 11 months (April 1 – February 29). This is not a bill to be paid as you still have the month of March to work on what is owed for this school year. In April you will receive a fundraising bill with the balance that is to be paid.

We are having a kite-fly on Friday, March 18, during all lunch periods in honor of St. Joseph. If you are able please come and help your child with their kites during their lunch recess. We hope it will be a good day for flying kites.

Thanks to your generosity, the school sent a \$375 check to Catholic Charities for “Project Love”. We also collected \$2,080.37 in our “Gina Jugs for U.M.D.F.” In the past 15 years we have sent \$23,915.48 for U.M.D.F. “Coins for a Cure”. The 5th grade won the field trip prize for grades 5-8 to the research lab at the University of Pittsburgh. They collected \$296.07. The 1st grade class won the prize for grades K-4, a trophy and a pizza/popcorn movie party. They collected \$492.69. Thank you and congratulations St. Bernadette School students!

The Gala committee is working hard on the upcoming event. Please lend your support for this major fundraiser. I hope that many of you have purchased your ticket.
